RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

- Classes 1-8 are open to anyone who wishes to enter.
- Exhibitors may enter one design in each Class.
- The Design entries cannot be changed in any way after judging must be maintained until the end of the Show.
- For Floral Design classes, lilies and other plant material do not have to be grown by the Exhibitor.
- A **fresh** lily or lilies (genus Lilium) must be included in each design. Lilies must be the **dominant** feature of the arrangement.
- The **antlers** (pollen) must be spresent on all blooms **unless** the bloom is of a pollenlless variety. Note that purchased lilies will often have these removed to keep the lily clean.
- No artificial flowers or foliage are permitted. Fresh, treated, or dried plant material is permitted. <u>Note</u> For classes 1, 2, and 3, gypsophila (baby's breath) is not permitted.
- Plant material cannot include any plants listed as noxious or prohibited noxious. This file has pictures and explanations:

- The **Basket** design may be made of any material but must have a handle visible **and** may be **viewed from all around.**
- **Class 9** is restricted to exhibitors <u>16 years of age or under</u> but youth exhibitors are encouraged to enter other classes if they wish.
